### **Perth Flying Squadron applies for expansion**

The Swan River Trust invites public comment on a proposal by the Perth Flying Squadron Yacht Club to redevelop and expand its facilities at The Esplanade, Dalkeith.

The proposed redevelopment includes expanding the club's marina to accommodate an additional 54 permanent boat pens, replacing fixed jetties with new floating jetties, new walling, and new public access and landscaping.

Other proposed new facilities include ten metre high boat stacking buildings for approximately 326 boats, boat lift facilities, a boat works yard and additions to the club house.

Public comment closes at 5pm on May 29, 2009. Submissions will be considered by the Trust before a recommendation is submitted to the Minister for Environment for final determination.
