



## Bellevue Community Consultative Committee

*Released: 09 July 2002*

The Minister for Environment set up the **Bellevue Community Consultative Committee** to ensure that the Bellevue residents and environmental groups are involved in decisions relating to the investigation and remediation of the Waste Control site. The committee also plays a key role in the dissemination of information to the local community.

The Bellevue Community Consultative Committee was established in mid-March 2002 and is made up of representatives of the:

- Bellevue Residents and Ratepayers Association;
- Bellevue Primary School P&C;
- Waste Control Fire Impact Support Group;
- Alliance for a Clean Environment; and
- Contaminated Sites Alliance.

Following agreement by the committee, representatives from the following agencies also attend the meetings on a regular basis:

- City of Swan;
- Department of Health;
- Office of the Minister for the Environment;
- Office for the Member for Midland; and
- Department of Environmental Protection.

The committee currently meets on a fortnightly basis.
